Eskişehir City Hospital, Serving Over 10.5 Million Patients, Celebrates Its 5th Year

Since its inception, the Eskişehir City Hospital, which has transformed Eskişehir into a health hub spreading healing to the region and becoming a center of attraction in various fields, celebrated its fifth anniversary with a ceremony.

The event was attended by Eskişehir Governor Hüseyin Aksoy, Eskişehir Metropolitan Municipality Deputy Mayor Ahmet İlker, Combat Air Force Commander İsmail Güneykaya, Provincial Gendarmerie Commander Brigadier General Erhan Demir, Provincial Police Chief Yaman Ağırlar, Eskişehir Provincial Health Director Specialist Dr. Yaşar Bildirici, Eskişehir City Hospital Chief Physician Assoc. Dr. Mustafa Sungur, Akfen Construction Chairman Selim Akın, Akfen City Hospitals General Manager Uğur Kılınç, and guests. Following the ribbon-cutting and opening speeches, plaques were presented, and a mini-concert was organized.

Eskişehir City Hospital, completed by Akfen Construction through the Public-Private Partnership (PPP) model and put into service by the Republic of Turkey Ministry of Health, celebrates its fifth anniversary. An event was organized for the fifth anniversary of Eskişehir City Hospital, which introduces Eskişehir and neighboring provinces to world-class advanced technology health services.

In five years, Eskişehir City Hospital served over 10.5 million patients, performing 236,000 surgeries. Over the past five years, besides health services, 9.35 million meals, 5.1 million kilograms of laundry, 8.6 million kilograms of waste collection, and 2.9 million sterilization and disinfection services were provided. Among the pioneering operations and treatments at the hospital are the challenging and delicate Epilepsy Pacemaker Surgery. Advanced diagnostic methods like the Cardiopulmonary Exercise Test, which examines respiratory systems and heart functions in detail, are also successfully implemented. Additionally, innovative and alternative treatment methods like Ozone Therapy are successfully conducted in the Traditional and Complementary Medicine (GETAT) Unit. Eskişehir City Hospital plays a leading role in regional health services with such innovative and pioneering treatment methods.

INNOVATIVE PRACTICES TRANSFORMING THE REGION

Eskişehir City Hospital continues to meet the region's health needs with its diverse service range. These innovative steps include the Healthy Aging Center, the Social Market established with a social responsibility mindset, the Eskişehir City Hospital Nursery for employees' families, and the Obesity Center, which is a significant part of public health. Also, the Geriatric Workshop offering specialized care for the elderly population, the



specialized Burn Center for burn patients, the Sleep Center treating sleep disorders, a unit performing therapeutic apheresis procedures, and the Chronic Wound Care Center specialized in treating chronic wounds are operational within the hospital. Along with these services, the Intensified Geriatric Care Program (YGAP) Unit offers comprehensive healthcare services to patients.

37 OPERATING ROOMS AND 254 POLYCLINIC ROOMS

Since its opening, Eskişehir City Hospital has successfully met the health needs of the local population and a broader region by offering modern health services over a wide area. Operating in a 333,000 square meter closed area, the hospital stands out with its state-of-the-art facilities and extensive capabilities.

Built on an area of 188,536 square meters, the hospital has a capacity of 1,150 beds, including 199 beds dedicated to intensive care. Eskişehir City Hospital offers health services across a broad spectrum with its 37 operating rooms and 254 polyclinic rooms.

Equipped with a heliport for rapid response to emergencies, the hospital also features a 2,300-vehicle capacity car park, providing significant convenience for patients and visitors.
