Tony Cragg

With an exploration of absurdity and ordinary reality, Wurm invites us to question our perceptions and embrace the unconventional. From his iconic "One Minute Sculptures" to his unique interpretation of clothing as a second skin, Wurm's works encourage us to engage with the world around us in new and unexpected ways.

Sylvie Fleury

Fleury's work transcends traditional boundaries, encompassing sculpture, performance, installation, and painting. By repurposing ready-made objects and questioning the fetishization of luxury goods, Fleury invites us to rethink the transient nature of value and meaning. Her critical reflections on temporality and consumer culture prompt us to reconsider our relationship with materials and desire.
